## SHINHAN BANK JOINS COMMUNITY'S RELIEF EFFORTS TOWARD THE CENTRAL, VIETNAM

Ho Chi Minh City, 05 November 2020 — Shinhan Bank Vietnam Limited ("Shinhan Bank") joined with Quang Binh Radio and Television to have two relief visits to Le Thuy District and Quang Ninh District, Quang Binh Province, provided aids and donations to help the disaster victims overcome the havoc caused by the historical floods here. The total amount contributed by Shinhan Bank to this relief campaign was up to VND 528,535,332 thanks to the voluntary contribution of Shinhan Bank Vietnam's members and meaningful internal activities to raise charity funds for the flood-victims in the Central, Vietnam.

My Thuy Commune, Le Thuy District, Quang Binh Province, where was hardest hit by the recent serious floods, was the first destination of Shinhan Bank in this relief journey on 4<sup>th</sup> November 2020. The journey continued with the next destination in An Ninh Commune, Quang Ninh District, Quang Binh Province to provide food and necessaries to 630 victim families here.
